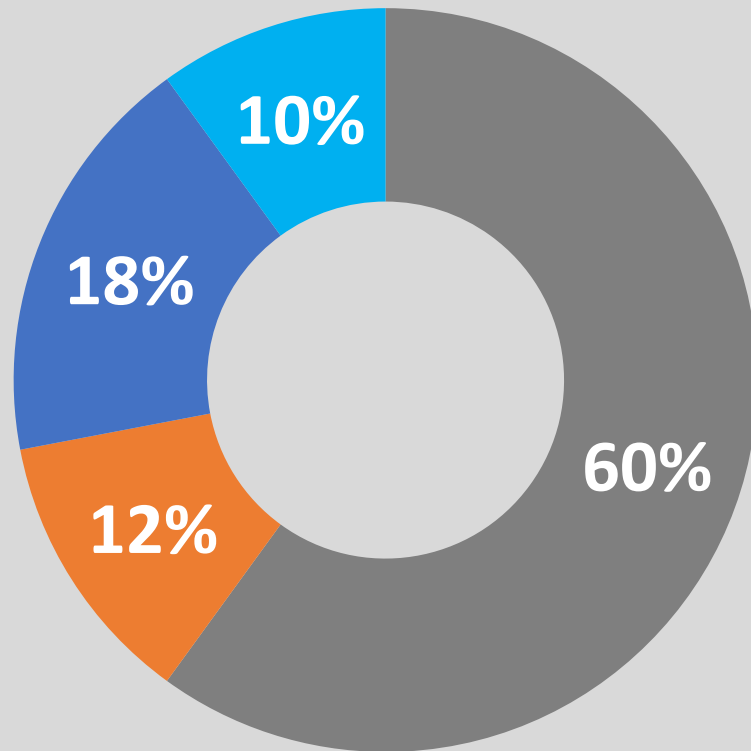


# Black residents make up 8% of Greater MSP's population

Population by race/ethnicity, 2018



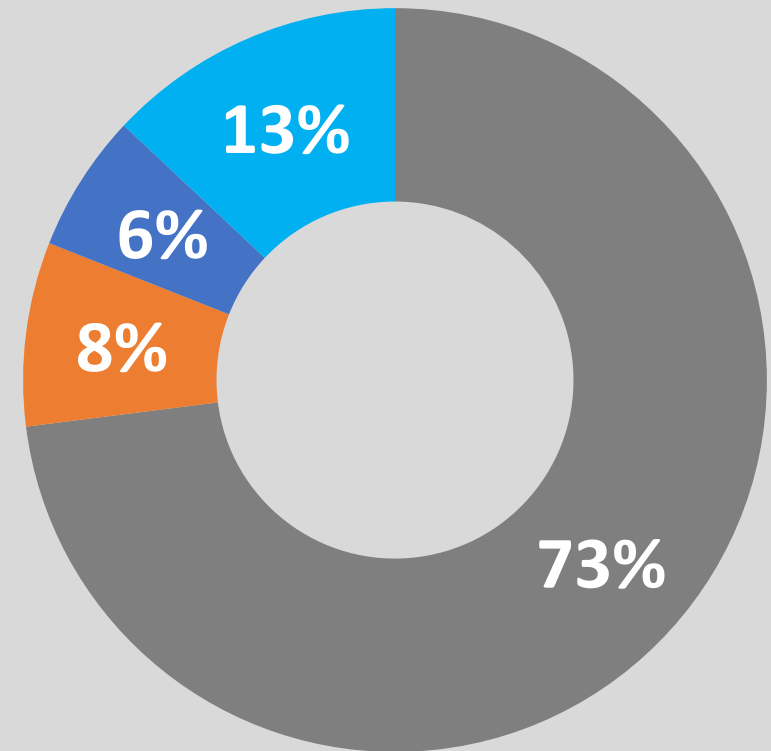

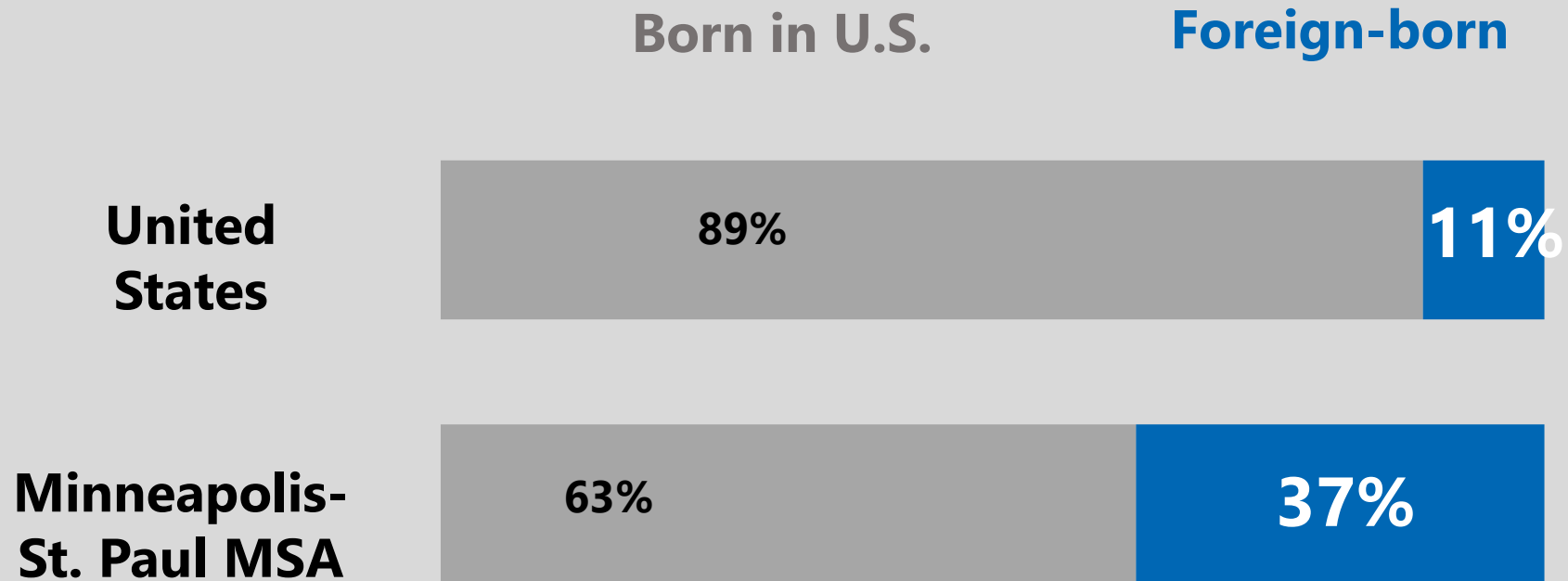

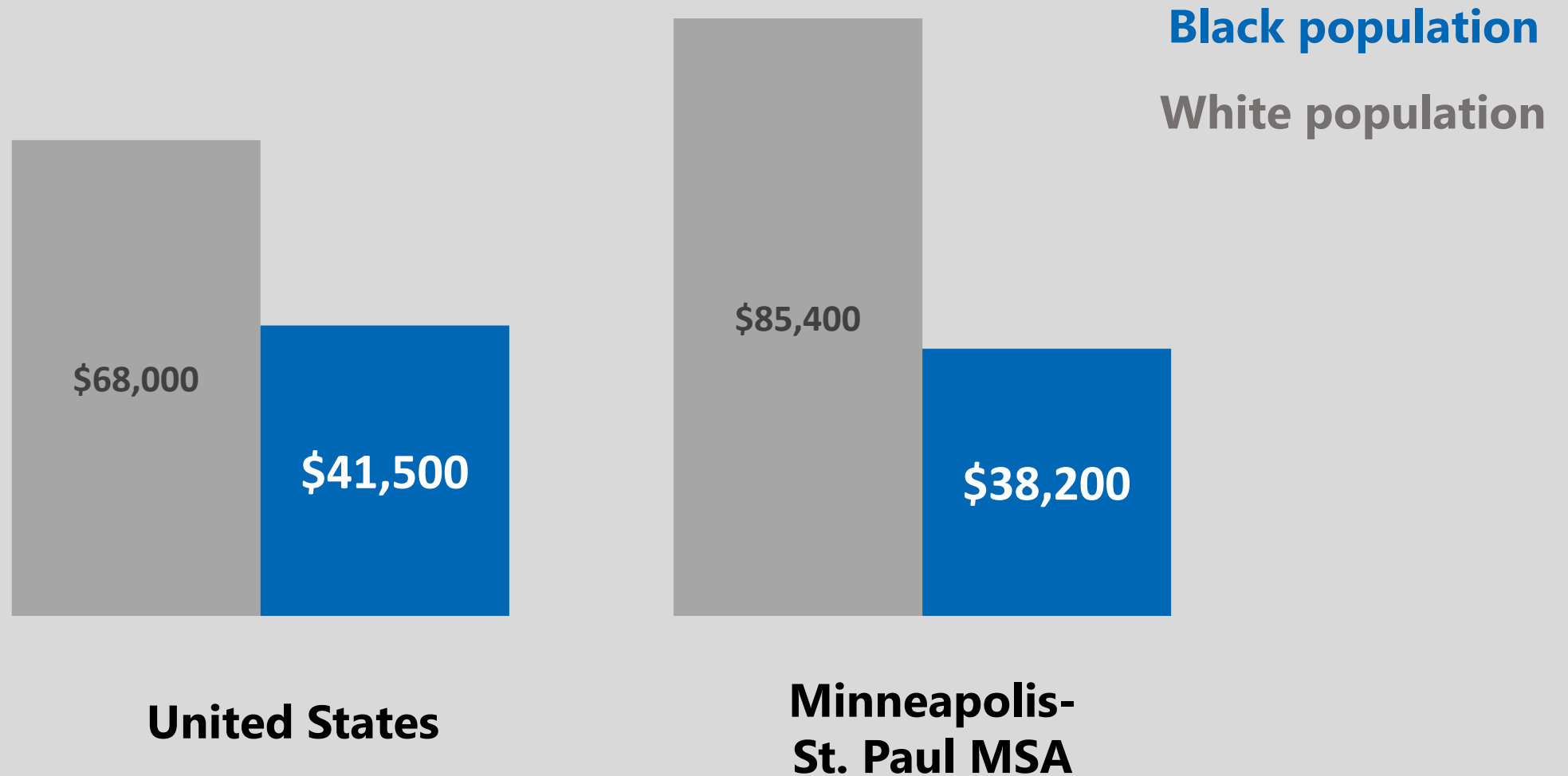
# MSP's Black residents include a large share of immigrants

Median household income, 2018

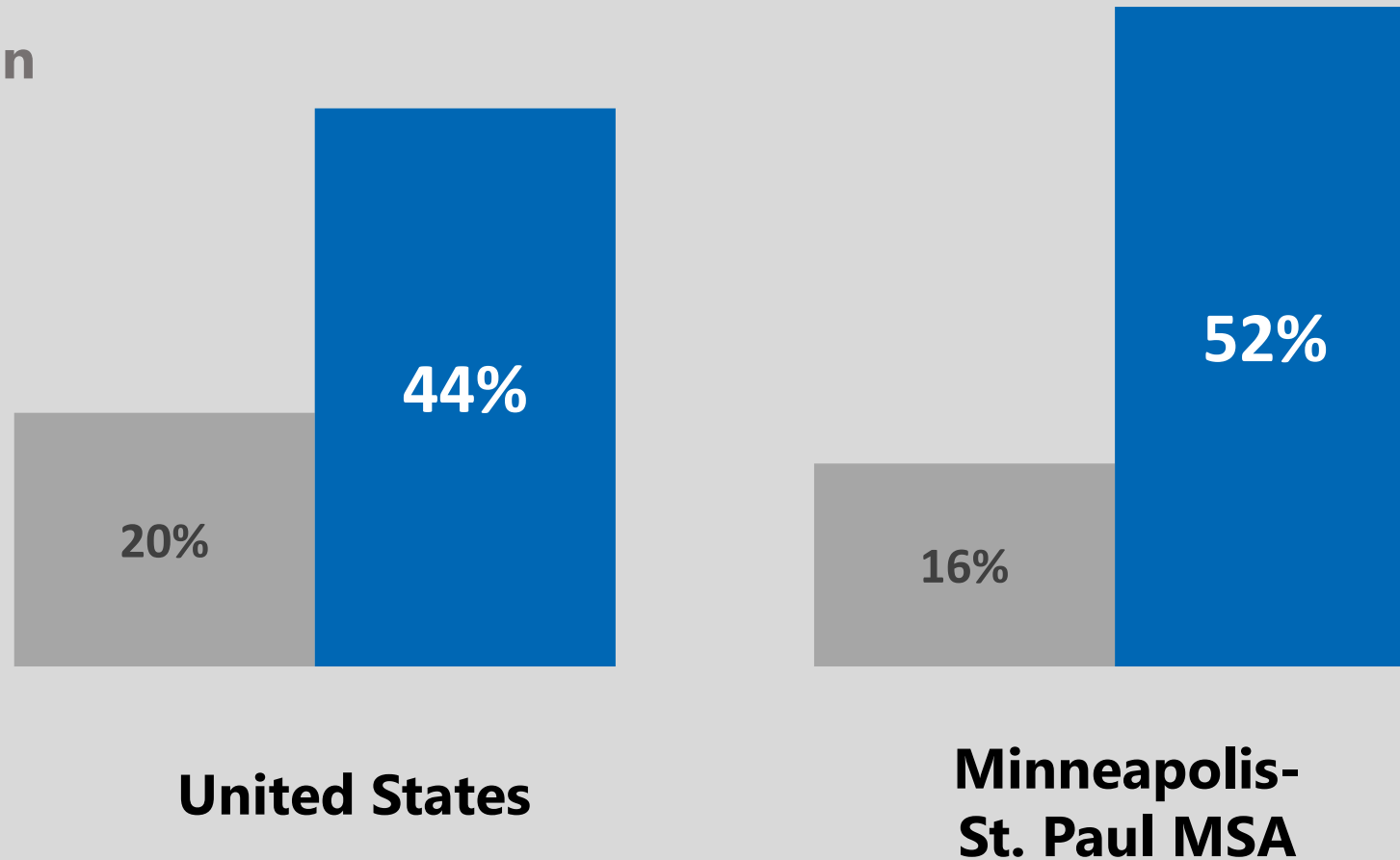


# MSP's Black residents are more likely to experience asset poverty

Share of residents without sufficient net worth to subsist at poverty level for 3 months without income

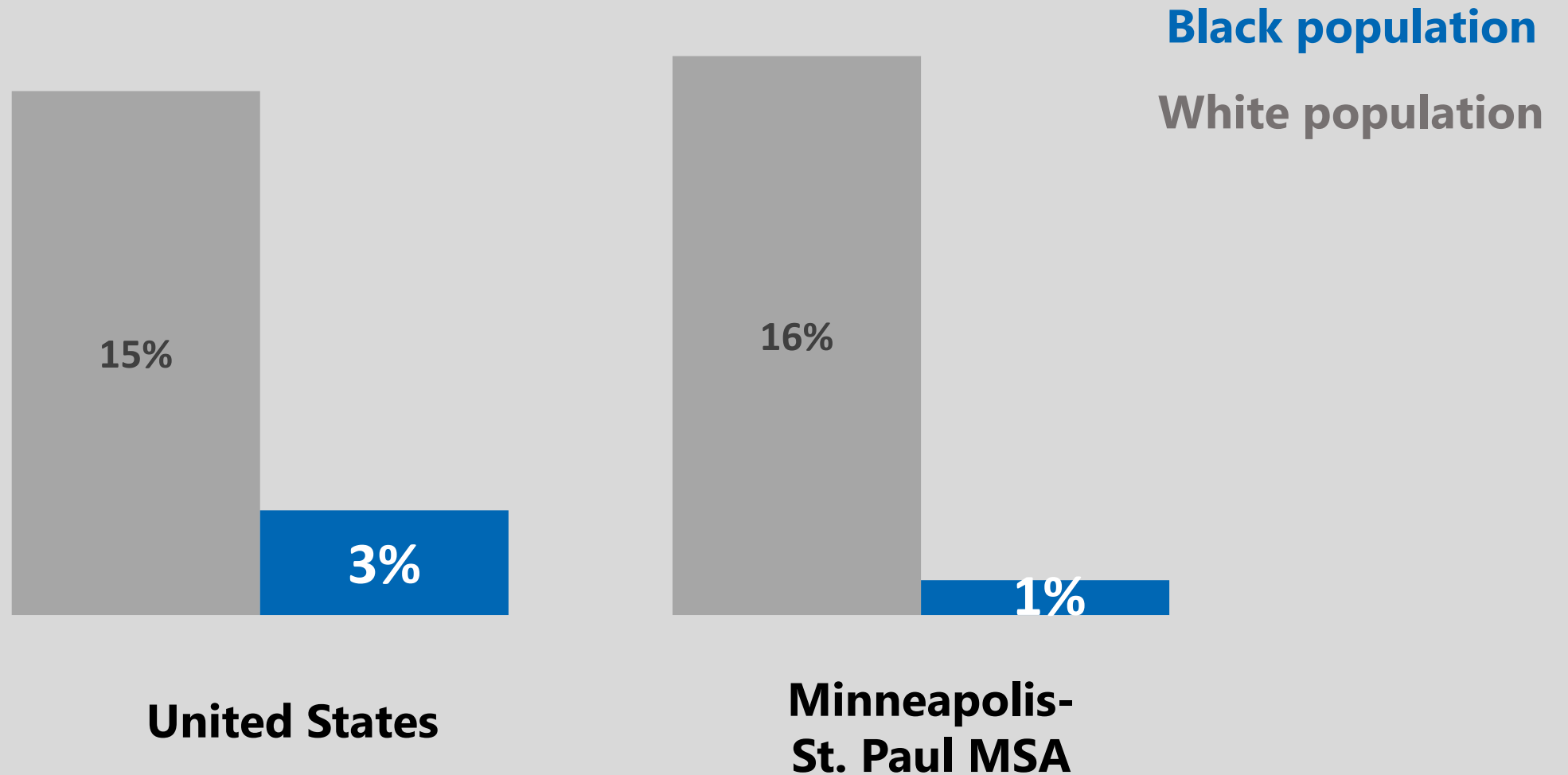

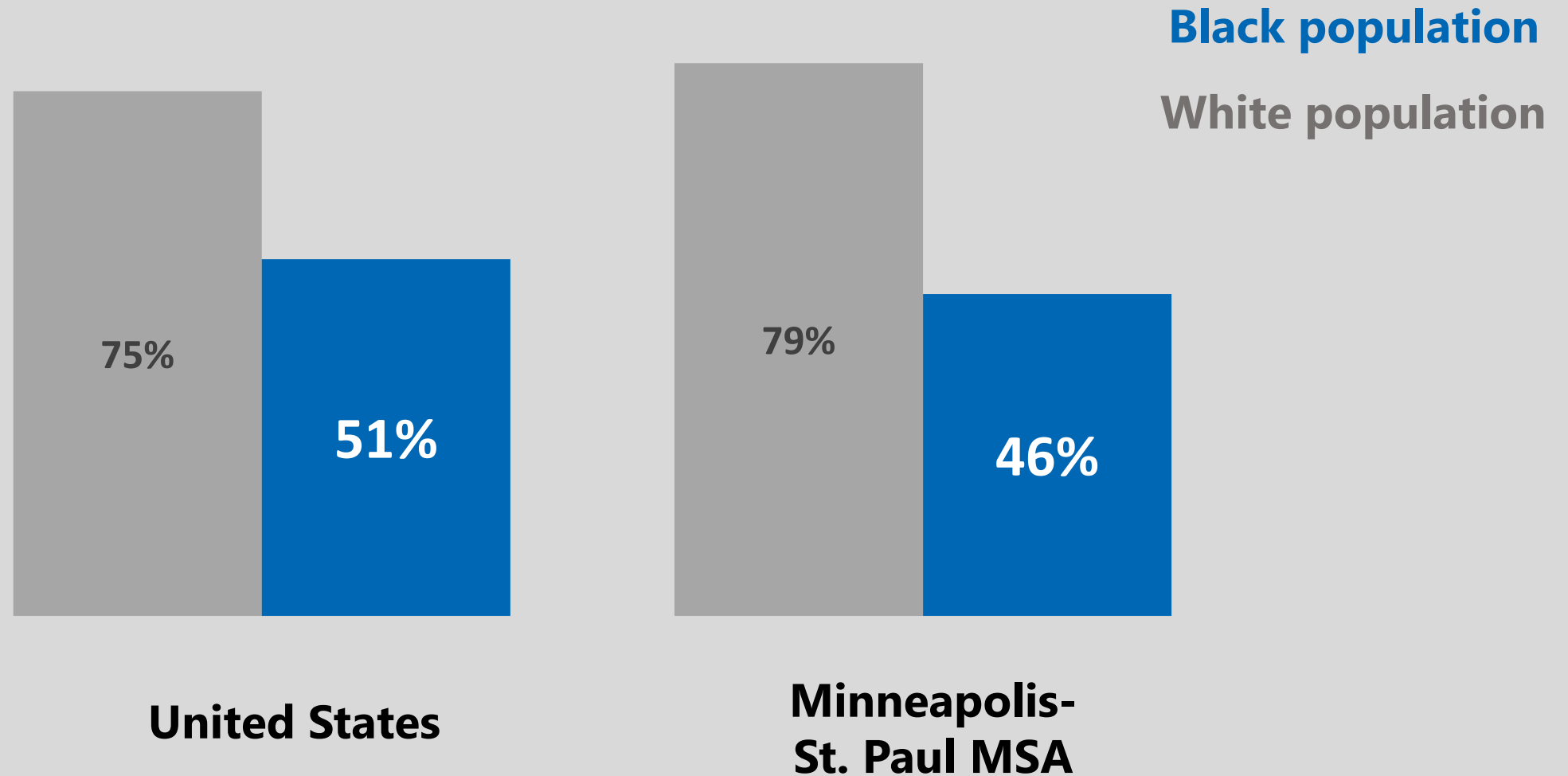
# Very few Black MSP residents enjoy investment income

Share of adults with positive interest, dividend, or rental income, 2018



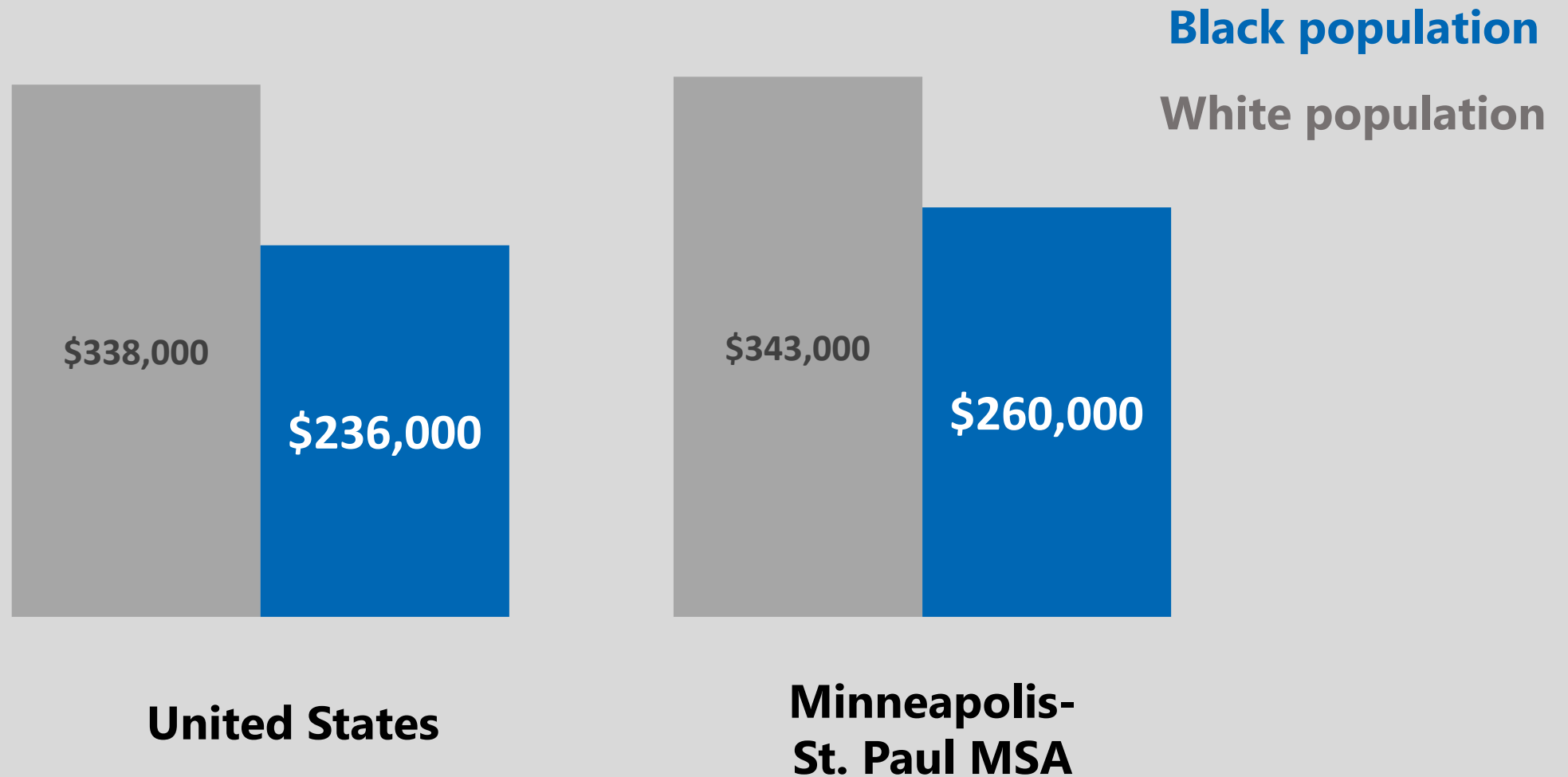
# Among middle-income households, the Black-white homeownership gap is larger in MSP

Share of households with \$50k-\$100k income owning their home, 2018



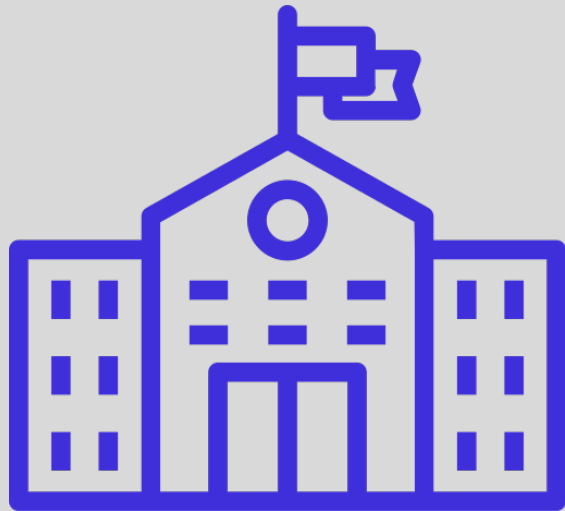
# MSP's Black homeowners enjoy higher average home values than those elsewhere

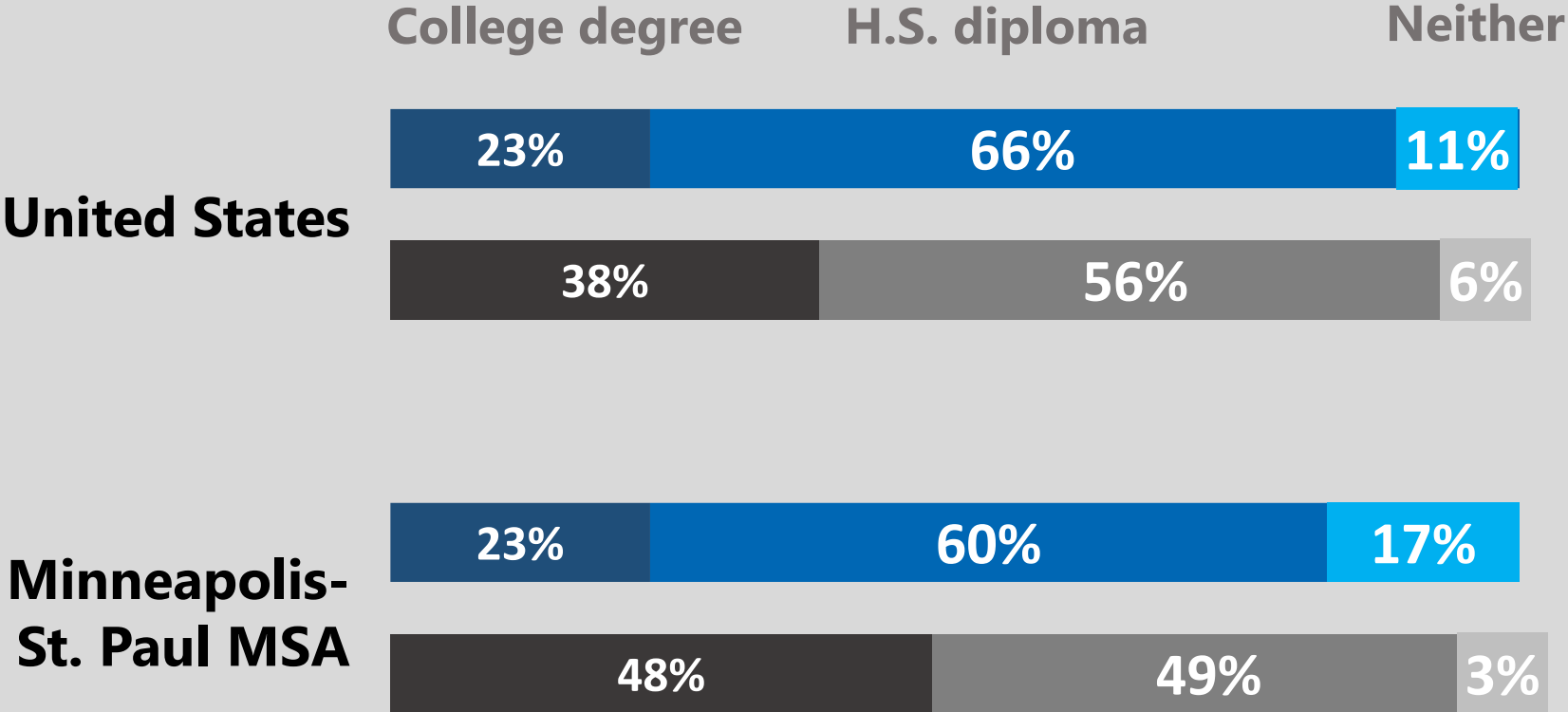
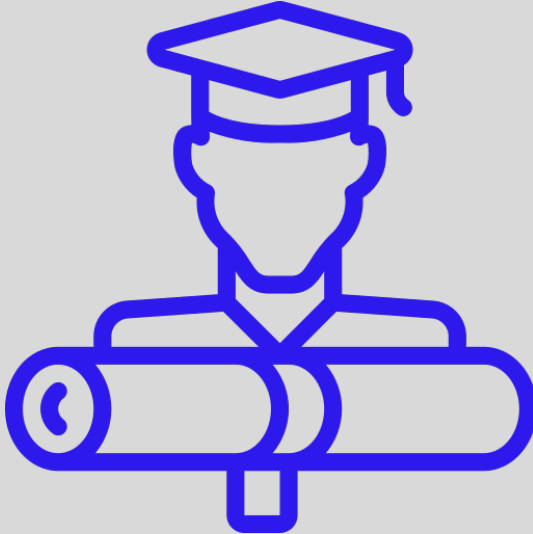

**White adults**

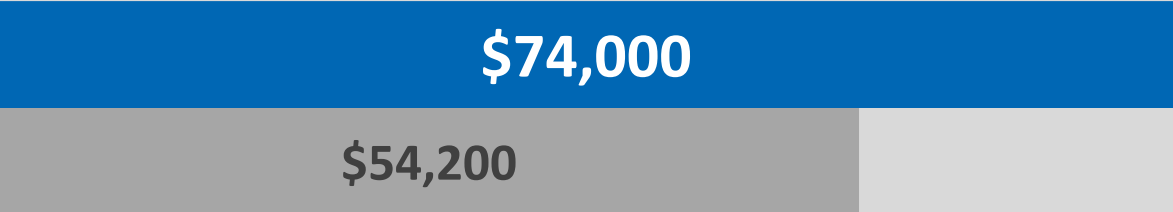
